

Motion concerning administration of student affairs.

“Based on the information gathered and presented to the **Faculty General Assembly** it is necessary to move for a **vote of no confidence in Dr. Chris Farren**, the Vice President of Student Affairs at WNMU.”

The information gathered concerning the confidence of the administration of Student Affairs is extensive. It includes areas of admissions and recruitment; student housing; the Academic Support Center, advising, and the Student Success Seminar; student discipline; student and campus safety; and lack of leadership, accountability and responsibility. The information gathered indicates that the **responsibilities** of the office of the Vice President for Student Affairs are **not being administered with the confidence that is deserved or is acceptable**. Disengagement and disinterest has resulted in incompetence and a denial of responsibility by Dr. Farren and has resulted in a lack confidence in the office of Student Affairs. This resulting lack of confidence is **a detriment to the students, faculty and staff of WNMU** and does not fulfill the mission of the University. There is no confidence that issues in this area will be resolved by Vice President Farren. This motion of no confidence is made with the hope that a **replacement of leadership** in this most crucial office will bring effectiveness and progress that is so needed.
